



## Shawnee Historic District

The village of Shawnee in Perry County serves as a gateway to the Little Cities of Black Diamonds region and the Wayne National Forest. It is a Trail Town for the statewide Buckeye Trail, which is also headquartered here. Founded in 1872, Shawnee's population was impacted by thousands of immigrant workers came to the area to work in coal mines. Coal, oil, and clay deposits were also discovered, and mineral extraction continued as the dominant industry. The boom town would see huge growth with banks, saloons, stores, hotels, and, at one point, two opera houses. The Knights of Labor Opera House, built in 1881, is one of the oldest standing labor union halls in the United States. The three-story Tecumseh Theater was built on Main Street in 1908. By the 1920s, the coal boom was over, and economic decline followed. Shawnee and its Main Street have retained an original streetscape with buildings, overhanging porches, and details typical of the Victorian Era. Several photos can viewed for Invisible Ground on Main Street, look for the ground markers.


